


BACKGROUND

The company One Textile was established in 2010 as a fabric converter and wholesaler in Los Angeles. It was originally formed to supply fabrics to small boutique shops in Los Angeles and New York.

Over the past four years, One Textile has experienced tremendous growth by partnering with a clothing manufacturer that works closely with CMT (Cut, Make, Trim) companies in Guatemala. In 2019 alone, we supplied over 7 million yards of Los Angeles–made fabric to Guatemala.

With our new Guatemala office, we are now able to serve more customers by partnering with full-package manufacturers who require fabrics that cannot be sourced elsewhere.
